GCIAOCP Policy Addendum: Industrial Hemp

Any applicant desiring to produce organic industrial hemp must provide sufficient documentation to validate the requirements below:

- 1. Should a license, permit or registration be required by local, state, or federal regulatory authorities to legally produce industrial hemp the applicant will provide GCIAOCP documentation of such approval.
- 2. Only varieties of industrial hemp approved by regulatory authorities are eligible for organic certification.
- 3. The area planted will be identified by GPS coordinates and will be the same area as noted in any and all issued licenses, permits or registration.
- 4. Growers may be required by regulatory agencies to obtain THC test results according to applicable regulations. If required the applicant will submit these results to GCIAOCP before organic certification can be completed.
- * All items above will be implemented and paid for by the applicant.
